Specific Duties

- Teach elementary school or middle school students academic, social, and motor skills in summer school program
- Deliver prepared course objectives and outline for course of study following curriculum guidelines and requirements of Seattle Public School District
- Lectures, demonstrates, and uses audiovisual teaching aids to present subject matter to class
- Administers, and corrects tests, and records results
- Assigns lessons, corrects papers, and hears oral presentations
- Maintains order in classroom, in lunchroom, during activities (often facilitated by an outside person or group), and during dismissal
- Counsels pupils when adjustment and academic problems arise
- Discuss pupils' academic and behavioral attitudes and achievements with parents
- Keeps attendance and grade records as required by school
- May teach combined grade classes
- Timely completion of all paperwork including, but not limited to: timesheets, student progress reports, and behavior forms
- Commit to Summer Academy daily schedule for the duration of the program
- Communicate with parents when student is absent from class

Requirements:

- Valid Washington State Teacher's Certificate
- Commitment to social skills development, individual attention for students
- Demonstrate initiative and high level of responsibility
- Must be flexible with very quick problem-solving abilities
- Effective written and verbal communication
- Extraordinary organizational skills
- Proven ability to handle multiple tasks under pressure
