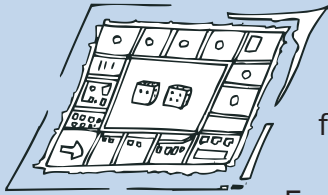


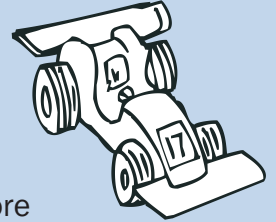


Help a child this Holiday Season!



Imagine not being able to provide toys or other gifts for your kids during the holidays. For many of the families we work with at **Atlantic Street Center**, this is a reality. Often, every spare cent is used for food and housing, leaving little—if anything—for presents.

Each year Atlantic Street Center helps make the holidays happier for these families by providing toys, books, games, and gift certificates for children and teens through our Holiday Assistance Program. Parents shop for their kids at the Holiday Assistance “store,” selecting gifts for each of their kids. There is no cost to parents to participate because the toy store is stocked entirely with gifts generously donated by people in the community. This year, **ARAMARK, Toys for Kids, Alaska Airlines, and Titan Worldwide** will partner with us to donate toys and other gifts. Last year, 1,300 children received toys and gifts.



How you can help

1. Organize a gift drive to collect donations for our “Toy Store.” We need educational toys and games, as well as multi-ethnic dolls and books for children aged 0-11. We also need gifts appropriate for older youth aged 12-17.
2. Raise money for food vouchers and gift certificates.
3. Make festive stockings for parents to fill with goodies.
4. Donate gift wrap, ribbons, bows and scotch tape.
5. Volunteer to help at the event on Wednesday, December 17, 2008 or to help with preparations or clean up.

- Only new, non-violent, unwrapped toys and gifts can be accepted. Clean, gently used coats are also welcome.
